

Other Ways to Give

Stewardship / CAF:

Donations can be made by using your Stewardship or CAF charity accounts.

Please note that such services do make charges for their administration which is often deducted from the reclaimed tax.

Donations can be made via Stewardship or CAF online accounts or using vouchers.

To send a donation via a charity voucher, simply complete your Stewardship or CAF charity voucher, and post it to us with a note explaining how you want the gift allocated.

We will process the donations via Stewardship or CAF, including charity cheques as soon as we receive the funds into our bank account direct from Stewardship or CAF.




In order to cover the card processing fees we incur, we will charge a 1% administration fee on all Debit card transactions and a 2% administration fee on all Credit card transactions



If you would like to send a donation by cheque, bankers draft or postal order, please make them payable to **"New Tribes Mission"**, and include a note mentioning who/what the donation is for and send to the finance office.

Then your money could go further.



Gift Aid:

If you are a UK taxpayer, Gift Aid is one of the simplest and most effective ways of increasing your giving to charity. It is a scheme introduced by HM Revenue & Customs which allows us to reclaim the basic rate of tax you pay as a UK taxpayer. Gift Aid is worth at least an extra 25p for every £1 you give. This is at absolutely no extra cost to you! The scheme covers single donations or regular donations of any value. You may sign a Gift Aid declaration covering all future gifts or you may sign a declaration just to cover one specific gift. If your circumstances change or you no longer wish to subscribe to the scheme you can cancel your declaration at any time. The form is available on our website or can be requested from our office.



Common Questions

How are NTM-UK missionaries supported?

NTM-UK does not pay a salary to anyone whether serving on home staff or abroad. All members are full-time missionaries who in faith look to the Lord for provision of their financial needs.

They are encouraged to tell others about their ministry and be open about their needs in a way that does not compromise their confidence in God. Support comes from sending churches, with additional help from other churches, family, friends and other individuals.

The full amount of each donation will be given to the missionary or project for which the donation is specified. *(Less card payment fees, if applicable)*

How is the NTM-UK financed?

NTM-UK relies on donations to support the operating expenses of the headquarters and to finance any current projects. Unspecified gifts may also be used to help meet these financial needs.

Making an online donation on our website is completely safe. When you make a donation, your web browser connects to a secure server. Any personal information you enter onto our online donation pages (including credit or debit card number, name and address) is encrypted before being sent to our card payment processor. They store your information in a carefully controlled environment using industry standard practices.
