The last consultant check will, Lord willing, be this November, when the Gospel of Matthew and the last seven chapters of Luke will be checked. All that which has been accomplished is by the grace of God. Lív's prayer in the last years has been that she might be able to complete the New Testament, and that day has arrived. She is deeply thankful to the Lord and very humbled that He has allowed her to have a part in this work. May many of this people group come to know the truth by reading His Word in their own language.

On the 35th anniversary of Paul and Marina Briggs' arrival as missionaries in a Loron village, they were thrilled to see how the Lord continues to work among the Loron people in Ivory Coast. Seventy-five new Loron believers were baptised on the 28th August this year. They came from several Loron villages, including one where the Gospel had recently been taught for the first time. Paul and Marina now serve itinerantly from their home in Northern Ireland. They are thankful for your prayers.

SWEET TO THE SOUL

After years of work, the Maliyali people finally have the opportunity to hear God's talk in their heart language. The teaching through evangelistic chronological Bible lessons started on August 29th! Pray that the Lord would be softening the hearts of the Maliyali people! Pray that when they hear God's Word it would be sweet to their souls! Pray for the three missionary families as this next season will be very intense, filled with a lot of hard work! It will take about four months, meeting four days a week. Pray that by December, after the Gospel has been presented in full, there would be Maliyali believers.

God is answering so many prayers. The people are COMING! They seem invested, interested and eager to talk about the teaching afterwards! The teaching is being recorded so the people can take the tiny recorders back to their houses and re-listen to the teaching.


